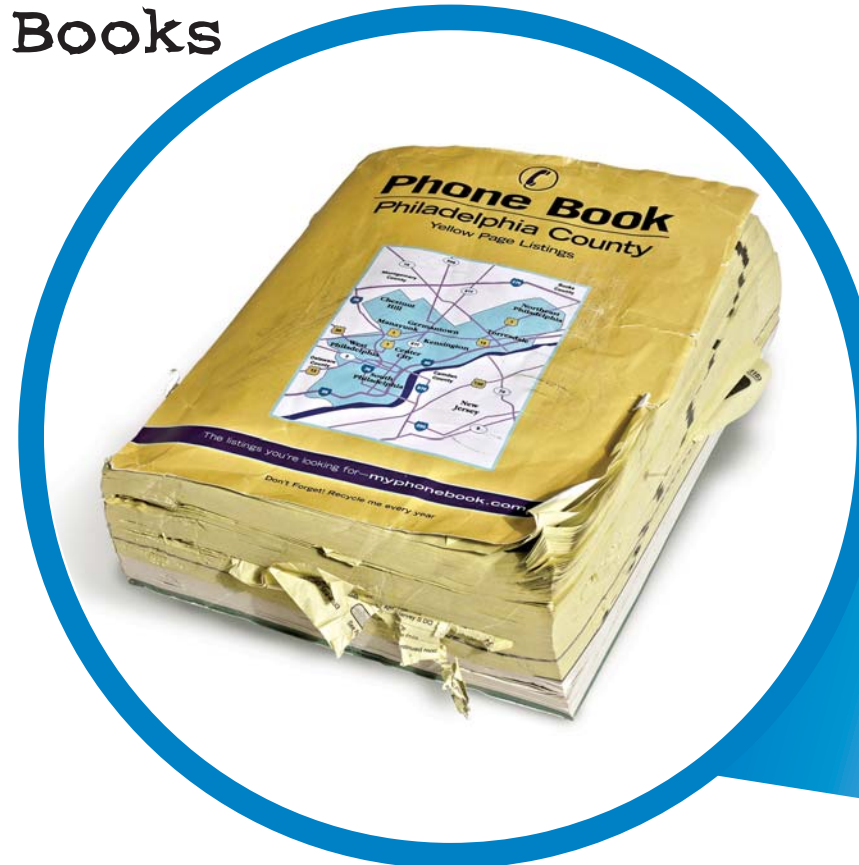

## Recycle like you've never recycled before.

Now you can put cans, glass and mixed paper out at the curb in the same recycling bin. And, for the first time, add plastic containers and cardboard to the mix!

**Cans:** Tin and aluminum cans, empty aerosol cans, empty paint cans

**Glass:** Jars and bottles

**Mixed Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, mail (junk and personal), phone books, food boxes (remove plastic liner), computer paper, flyers, wrapping paper (no foil or plastic wrap), beverage cartons (no food-soiled paper, please!)

**Plastic Containers:** Recycle #1 and #2 plastics ONLY (mostly beverage and detergent containers). Look for the number on the bottom of the container to see if it's acceptable.

**Cardboard:** Empty and flattened

If one recycling bin isn't enough to hold everything, just add another container.
